Gist in respect of 1975 MI5 Leak Inquiry

In January 1975, reliable intelligence obtained by the Security Service in the course of a leak inquiry indicated that Colin WALLACE intended to remain in contact with the journalist Robert FISK after WALLACE's departure from Northern Ireland, and that he promised to provide FISK with a significant news scoop.
